Today's program was about Kamp Kiwanis. Kamp Kiwanis was sold to the NY District Kiwanis Foundation in Dec 1968 for \$1. Kamp Kiwanis is located in Taberg, NY which is outside the City of Rome and is has 105 acres. The Kamp officially opened in 1971 with 6 cabins & an administration building. Additional cabins, an infirmary, art & crafts building, a theater, pool, lake and library have been built. The first two weeks each year are for adults with disabilities and then there are 6 weeks of kids attending camp. The campers are both regular campers and those with special needs and they are all mainstreamed into cabins and compete in the same activities. The weekly number of campers is about 130. They come from Sunday to Saturday each week. We showed a video of the Kamp! Each May the Kamp holds an open house and work weekend to get the Kamp ready for the summer.
