Arnot Realty also manages many multifamily spaces in Chemung County and more recently in Ithaca. Their goal is to reach 1000 units. At present they are at about 450 but are working on a 500-unit space – Waters Edge in Ithaca. All their rental space in Ithaca is rented for the upcoming school year.


