Program

Today's program was County Executive Chris Moss. Chris is an Elmira native and became County Executive in 2019. Prior to that he served as Chemung County Sheriff from 2006-2019. Chris talked about the budget process for the county which will be about 200-230 million dollars. Some of the highest cost items are equipment costs - ie the cost to replace a sheriff's car is about \$100,000 up from \$60,000 a few years ago. The sewer relocation project to Milton St is another huge project. Chris also said that although the county has about 1000 employees there about 150 jobin many openings that they can't fill as people who apply aren't able to pass the drug test or people just don't want to work. The homeless population in the county is another big issue and although it is not limited to Chemung County it causes a lot of problems as people don't want to follow the rules in the shelters they are sleeping outside in parks & under bridges. The homeless shelter by the community kitchen requires people to be inside by 7pm an out again at 7am. He also talked about the Arena, Airport, Nursing Facility and term limits. The County Executive and Council Members are limited to 3 – 4 yr terms or 12 years!
