Next year the fair will run for 5 days from Tuesday thru Saturday and they already have events scheduled. They will be bringing back the battle of the bands on one of the nights with a preliminary round in July to narrow it down to 4 bands to compete at the fair. They said that they are making a lot of improvements to the fair and Mark Watts was able to secure \$300,000 in state funding for Ag Societies. They said that it cost about \$232,000 to run the fair this past summer.

They have secured a 3-year contract with the ride company who will be bringing some new rides next summer. We mentioned that people did compliment the fair and the changes that wee made. They said it was a learning year for the Fair Board and they realize that there were some things that need improvement but over all it was a great fair!
