Program

Today's program was Angela Hawken, VP Eastern Region of Southern Tier Logistics. Working out of a single 40,000 sq. ft. warehouse in Findlay, OH, they began operations in June of 1988 as Findlay's Tall Timbers Distribution Center. The work ethic and commitment to customers and community led them to considerable and rapid growth. Today, they operate as Ohio Logistics successfully maintaining 25 locations serving seven states. With over 6 million sq. ft. of state-of-the-art warehouse space, we are one of the largest privately held logistics firms in the Midwest. The mission is to provide their customers with the best possible warehousing and transportation services while maintaining competitive and fair prices. One of their divisions is Southern Tier Logistics with facilities in Painted Post, Elmira, Elmira Heights & Horseheads. Their major facility is located in the Southern Tier Logistics Business Park which was previously known as either The Holding Point or The Center at Horseheads. They are a huge distribution facility having just built a new facility that is over a ½ mile long and can accommodate about 30 trucks leaving per hour and plan to have up to 300 trucks departing the facility per day! Siemens Mobility is building a facility in the business park that will produce high speed trains. Operation should begin in 2026 with 300 employees. ST Logistics is extremely community minded – Angela said she sits on several area boards, and they have sponsored the past 4 Honor Flights (taking Veterans to Washington DC).
