Today's program was the Ernie Davis Awards. The Ernie Davis award was first presented in 1963 to Ray Fratarcangelo from EFA. It's the award that's earned by the area's top high school football player. It is voted on by local coaches and media members. This year the 3 nominees are:

**Lucas Mosher** – Horseheads High School – Lucas paced the Blue Raiders to their first Section IV Class A championship since 1998. He was a standout running back who racked up 1,270 total yards and 21 touchdowns. In addition to football Lucas works to better the community, volunteering at food drives, wrestling clinics and youth sporting events.

**Nolan Edwards** – Elmira High School – Nolan helped the Express to the 2<sup>nd</sup> straight Section IV Class AA title as a cornerback and backup quarterback. Nolan had 24.5 tackles, 3 pass breakups an interception and a field goal block. In the community Nolan volunteers in youth and challenger sports, the Elmira Booster Club, Read for the Record. He is a member of the New Visions Program and National Honor Society.

**Jaden Bennett** – Thomas Edison – Jaden helped the Spartans to their best football season in over 17 years. The Spartan's 8-man team made their 1<sup>st</sup> playoff appearance since 2005 & earned their 1<sup>st</sup> winning season since 2007. Jaden volunteers with junior Rotarians, local food bank, Eldridge Park, while maintaining at 91 GPA!
