It is made u of over 300 different funds. They have multiple scholarships for students but also many grant programs for non-profits, initiatives and training, Youth Philanthropy. One of the programs involves going to second grade classrooms in area schools and teaching them about philanthropy and at the end of the program the classroom gets a \$100 to donate to a non-profit of their choice. The students must decide where it goes as a group. For all the different funds the Foundation manages the money & disperses it. Some funds are very specific other ones more general. The overall goal is to address today's needs through multiple avenues of funding and awareness and to find creative solutions for avoiding future problems. They pride themselves on being the only foundation in the area that looks at the holistic needs of the community, including education, arts, infrastructure, animals, the environment, and wellness. The Community Foundation started in the early 70's with separate Foundations in Elmira & Corning but they merged in 1993 & have grown to what they are today.
