Program

Our speaker today was Jamal Malik Chairman of the Chemung County Demographic Party. Jamal is an Elmira native. His family has been in the area for generations. His Great Great Great Grandfather escaped from slavery on a plantation in Maryland in 1850 and came to the Elmira area through the Underground Railroad. His father was the first African American Police Officer in Elmira. Jamal graduated from Elmira Free Academy and went on to earn degrees from SUNY Farmingdale and North Carolina Ag and Tech in the Engineering Field. He worked for an oil company for 17 years in the United Arab Emirates, retiring and coming back to the Elmira area in 2015. In Junior High, Jamal was selected to go to Boys State at Alfred University and his interest in politics was born. He has been a member of the CCDC since 2016 and got very involved after the January 6th attack on the Capitol. This election season, the CCDC has sponsored a weekly speaker series on Project 2025 and is currently working to register voters, phone banking and send get out the vote postcards. The Committee will be sending a bus to the Mansfield, PA area to help with canvassing. Jamal is concerned about violence after the November election. He is working hard to get the message out that above all, maintaining the social order and respecting others with different views needs to be our top priority.
